Jacksonville Symphony Welcomes Two New Board Members

Jacksonville, FL (February 14, 2018) --- The Jacksonville Symphony welcomes Douglas A. Booher of Fidelity National Title Group and Aubrey Edge, President and CEO of First Coast Energy, as new members of the Symphony Board.

Douglas A. Booher currently works with Fidelity National Title Group in their National Commercial Services Southeast operations. Booher is responsible for overseeing the delivery of title, escrow, underwriting and closing services for national customers in Florida and throughout the Southeast. Prior to this position, he served as national underwriting development counsel, recruiting, hiring and assisting with the development of underwriting counsel in all U.S. markets in which Fidelity is operating. As the chief claims counsel and claims center manager for Fidelity's Jacksonville Claims Center, Booher managed approximately 95 attorneys and 70 administrative and support personnel, who were responsible for administering the majority of lenders' and owners' claims on title policies issued by the Fidelity family of companies for the Eastern half of the United States and Latin America.

After graduating from the University of Florida, Booher practiced commercial litigation and real estate law for 11 years, handling numerous legal issues including commercial and real estate transactions and litigation, construction litigation and business negotiations and disputes. He spent seven years with The St. Joe Company, a Florida real estate operating company, becoming experienced in nearly all aspects of real estate development and operations as well as serving as assistant general counsel, responsible for managing the company's litigation. Prior to joining Fidelity, Booher served as the U.S. Counsel for a Brazilian conglomerate, focusing on the North American expansion and legal management of the company's cement, concrete and construction related operations.

Aubrey Edge has served as President and CEO of the First Coast Energy, LLP since its inception in 1997. From 1994-1997, Edge served as the President of Petro Distributing, Inc., a predecessor to First Coast Energy. Prior to 1994, Edge spent six years with BP Oil Company gaining experience in Real Estate, Retail Marketing, Operations, and Derivatives Pricing/Hedging. Edge holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia, where he graduated in 1988. Edge is married to Elizabeth and has two sons, Ryan, 18, and Christopher, 12.

Edge is a very active participant in the Jacksonville community. He and Elizabeth participate in many charitable endeavors through Daily's and privately. He currently sits on the Board of Directors for St. Vincent's Hospital, the Honorary Board of GPC (Growing Parenting Choices), The Players Championship Council, the Parent Development Board of Auburn University and The Bolles School Board of Trustees. He is also the current Chair of the national Wholesale Council for Shell Oil Company.

Edge and Daily's host "Daily's The Tradition," a charitable gold tournament which raises money for the St. Vincent's Mobile Healthcare Ministry. This ministry provides much needed health care to underprivileged children and their families throughout Northeast Florida. The tournament, now in its ninth year, routinely nets more than \$450,000 per year.

"We are excited to welcome Douglas and Aubrey," said Symphony President and CEO Robert Massey. "Their experience and expertise make them valued additions to our Board."
