Art Walk Passport: For those who attend any of the Symphony ensemble performances, there are opportunities to win **FREE** Symphony tickets for concerts remaining in the 2017-2018 season. Passports can be turned in to a Symphony staff member at any of the ensemble locations. To receive credit, you must stop by the locations and have a Symphony staff member stamp or hole punch their Passport card.
