JACKSONVILLE SYMPHONY ANNOUNCES PARTNERSHIP WITH BLACK KNIGHT PROVIDING FREE TICKETS TO ACTIVE MILITARY AND VETERANS

Jacksonville, FL (March 24, 2021) --- The Jacksonville Symphony and Black Knight recently signed a sponsorship agreement that will bring free Symphony tickets to veterans and active members of the U.S. military. Titled the "Black Knight Veterans Ticket Program," the sponsorship will provide 300 free tickets for veterans and active members of the U.S. military throughout the remainder of the 2020/21 Jacksonville Symphony season.

"The Jacksonville Symphony is committed to expanding access to the arts," says Symphony President & CEO Steven Libman. "We are incredibly grateful that Black Knight's sponsorship will provide us the amazing opportunity to expand that access to active members of our military, veterans, and their families."

The Black Knight Veterans Ticket Program will allow veterans and active members of the U.S. military with valid documentation to receive two complimentary tickets to select performances. Additional tickets can also be purchased at a reduced price point unique to members and veterans of the U.S. military.

How to Participate:

To take advantage of this program, participating members must visit the Symphony Box Office, call the Box Office at 904.354.5547, or email at boxoffice@jaxsymphony.org. They will be required to provide documentation of their U.S. military active duty or veteran status in one of three ways:

- Physically present the ID at the Symphony Box Office

- Fax a copy to 904.354.9238

Once the ID has been sent, it will not need to be presented again.

Tickets are available for most upcoming Jacksonville Symphony performances in the Florida Blue Masterworks and Fidelity National Financial Pops Series. There are a limited number of complimentary tickets available for each performance, and ticket reservations will be first come, first served. The Symphony encourages interested members to reserve their tickets early.
