What: Mayor Donna Deegan declared September 21 as the official Jacksonville Symphony Day in honor of its 75 years of cultural contributions to the city. The proclamation was announced Friday, September 20 during the 104.5 WOKV morning show recorded live in Jacoby Symphony Hall. September 21 is when the Jacksonville Symphony was incorporated in 1949 and marks the date of the upcoming 75th Anniversary Opening Night with Mahler's Symphony No. 2, "Resurrection." The Symphony is thrilled to recognize this day in celebration of enriching the community through symphonic music.
